MEET DIRECTOR

The Meet Director shall have direct control over all activities, including warm ups and cool downs, except for those activities coming under the control of the Referee as per the Rules of Swimming. Any acts of misconduct, or failure to abide by a reasonable direction from the Meet Director, or his/her delegate, by any person may result in that person being removed from the swimming pool. In the event of misconduct by a swimmer, the Meet Director shall have the authority to exclude the swimmer from an event, or in cases of serious misconduct, exclusion from any part of the program. Any sanction/s shall be the sole discretion of the Meet Director. In addition the Referee and Meet Director have authority to control heats at their discretion and may combine heats to be swum as a straight-out final

VENUE INFORMATION

Entry: Entry for swimmers and spectators is \$3.20, a Family Pass for 2 adults and 2 children (under 16 years) is available for \$10.00. Entry to the pool is via the grandstand (Gate 3), the main reception desk is not to be used for swimmer or spectator entry. Swimmers are not to use their Aqua Cards or WAIS Cards to gain entry into the venue.

Coaches are admitted free of charge by showing their ASCTA Coaching Accreditation.

Parking: There will be another event being held at Challenge Stadium on Friday 10th February. The car park will be busier than usual on this day. Parking attendants will be working on that day. You are advised to arrive early on this day, before 4:30pm where possible to avoid any fees.

SEATING

Based on results from 2011 Premierships Clubs are allocated seats for competitors and spectators for their respective divisions. Clubs are allocated a lane which will be used for the duration of the event in addition to warm-ups. Please refer to the Seating Plan for each Division for details.

Please note: Parents and Spectators are forbidden on pool deck at all times.

WARM UP PROCEDURES

All coaches and swimmers must be aware of general warm up procedures as follows:

The following general pool procedures for the **MAIN COMPETITION POOL** must be observed throughout the meet:

- All Clubs must warm-up only in their allocated lane as shown above

The following general pool procedures for the **DIVE POOL** must be observed throughout the meet:

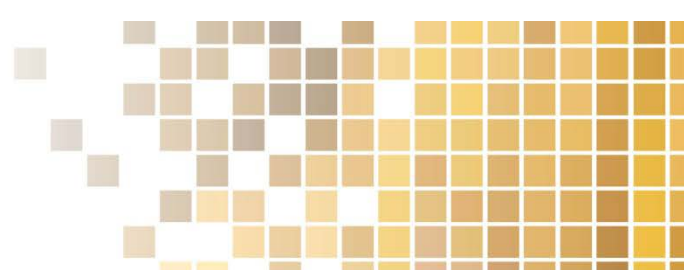
- Lanes 1 - 3 are designated for the duration of the meet as circle swimming lanes
- Feet first entry only
- Lane 4 is designated for the duration of the meet as a pace lane

In addition to the procedures above be aware of announcements to determine lane usage throughout the meet, as usage may vary at the discretion of the Meet Director.

Additional Information:

- The Meet Director may at any time remove a swimmer from the warm up pool if he or she does not abide by these procedures.
- Swimmers must leave the water by the end of the warm up session as published in the meet program, or when requested. Swimmers who do not exit the pool when requested to do so may be disqualified from that day's competition. The request to leave the pool will be announced 15 minutes prior to the advertised start time of meet.

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MARCH PAST

All Clubs are to assemble on the grassed area between the 50m competition and water polo pools, 5min prior to the listed time for the March Past. Clubs will march past in the order as shown from right to left in the seating allocation (i.e for A Division: Arena, Western Sprint, West Coast etc)

All Clubs are asked to supply a song for their march past no later than Wednesday 8th February 2012 at 5:00pm preferably as an MP3 file via email to Kate Symons: kate@wa.swimming.org.au

There will be a prize for the "Best Dressed Club" in each division of a Swimmer's World Voucher to the value of \$200.00

PROGRAM OR EVENTS

The Club Premierships consist of individual events and team events (relays). Each swimmer may compete in a maximum of two (2) individual events as well as any number of team events. Any club swimming an unregistered swimmer in this competition will be disqualified completely and zero points will be recorded for the entire meet.

Points will be allocated as follows:

Individual Events: 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

Team Events: 12, 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2

MARSHALLING

All swimmers will marshal before each event in the designated area. Swimmers are requested to report to the marshal promptly when the event number is displayed on the marshalling board and have their names marked off.

Any entrant, who fails to report to the marshalling area at least ten (10) minutes prior to scheduled time for the start of the session (if entered in the 1st or 2nd event) or, at least two (2) events prior to the event in which she/he is entered, shall be deemed to be a withdrawal.

WITHDRAWING FROM EVENTS AND SUBSTITUTIONS

Each Club has listed two (2) reserves for each event, these are the only swimmers who be used as substitutions. The Team Manager must submit a Substitution Slip to the Meet Director at least five (5) events prior to the event in which the substitution is being made, any club failing to do so will be unable to claim the times swum.

RELAY ENTRIES

Clubs will need to submit a 'hard copy' Relay Team Slip Form with names and correct order of swimmers and hand to the Chief Recorder/Meet Director no later the sixty (60) minutes prior to the start of the meet. Only those swimmers originally listed in the electronic team file submitted to Swimming WA are eligible

Relay Team Slips are to be handed in to the Omega Room located on pool deck - access will be via the back corridor under the grandstand.

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DISQUALIFICATIONS

Shall be announced.

CLUB SHIELDS

The winning Club will be presented with a Club Shield at the conclusion of the event. The Club shield will remain with the Club until Friday 26th April, at which time it must be returned to the Swimming WA office.

The winning Club will be presented the Club Shield along with the Club Pennant at the 2012 Vorgee Swimmer of the Year Breakfast to be held at the Burswood Entertainment Complex, Saturday 26th May 2012.

VOLUNTEERS ROSTER

As per Swimming WA's policies, based on entry numbers, clubs are allocated volunteer duties. It is the responsibility of each club to ensure they have people available to fill these duties to allow the meet to run smoothly. The approximate times that Volunteers are required for each duty will be listed on the Volunteer Roster. It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that volunteers are available for the duration of the time listed.

All volunteers (including time keepers) who require pool deck access are to enter the area via the swim school office only. All other access points are not to be used for the duration of the competition.

All Clubs are required to have four (4) volunteers available for Club premierships, Volunteers will be used for timekeeping and other duties as required.

ACCESS TO TECHNICAL OFFICIALS DURING THE MEET

Persons requiring access to Officials during this event for the purposes of lodging a protest, appealing or seeking clarification of an infringement, ruling or any other matter, shall direct all requests through the Meet Director, in accordance with SWA Policies.
