President's Report

West Coast Swimming Club has emerged from a season of challenges with the future of the Club in good hands in and out of the pool.

The changing face of the Club is evident in both our swimming and administrative areas, but has been especially highlighted by a membership surge in our junior ranks which complements the quality of our age swimmers coming through the ranks.

Everyone at the Club deserves a huge pat on the back with news that West Coast has been awarded Gold status in the 2009-10 Australian Unity GO Club PB rankings by Swimming Australia. This status is graded across 5 key areas (memberships, administration, activities, coaching/officiating and marketing/promotion). The program benchmarked our Club against clubs from other states across the country, as well as monitoring changes to our own Club's performance from year to year. This is a commendable achievement, improving our status from "Silver" level in 2008-09.

It's appropriate to use the 5 key measurements from the GO Club rankings to assess our own year:

Membership (Swimming):

On the swimming front, our members were able to record some fantastic individual and team performances throughout the year.

It was a very proud moment last month for all West Coast members and supporters when our very own Tommaso D'Orsogna was crowned Swimming WA's "2010 Vorgee Swimmer of the Year". Congratulations to Tommaso and his family who have contributed so much to the rich history of the West Coast Swimming Club.

Nationally, West Coast was well represented at Open and Age level competition. This is a credit to Mel Tantrum and her coaching team, who have worked hard to re-build our competitive profile following the departure of a number of senior swimmers.

Unfortunately we were unable to retain the A-Grade Premiership title for a record 10th successive year, but it was a great effort by all our members to maintain our position in this elite division. The challenge for the Club is to now climb back to the top and with so many of our younger swimmers having previously tasted A-Grade glory, I've no doubt the hunger exists for a new generation of swimmers to make their own mark in the Club's folklore.

Especially rewarding was the Club's involvement in the Blue Colour Pennant, which West Coast won against some quality opposition. 85 members got the opportunity to swim on behalf of the Club; many of them recorded Personal Best times and swam in relay teams for the first time.

Our Club Nights have gone from strength-to-strength and have provided current and potential members and their families with a great feeling of "community". Attendances are averaging 70+ swimmers per meet, all of whom are gaining valuable race experience on a monthly basis. For many members, Club Nights have also provided the added bonus of an opportunity for them to achieve qualifying times without having to travel to "non-targeted" meets. There has been a greater level of coordination between Club Night event selection and the coaching team, which has resulted in a great deal of

positive feedback. Special thanks must be made to Karen & Steven Hodgetts who make themselves available to officiate every month, as well as the parents who volunteer to be timekeepers.

Administration:

There has also been much progress going on behind the scenes.

A review of the Treasurer's Report and financial statements included in this Annual Report will confirm that this Club's "cash at bank" position is very healthy. The Club's financial stability means we are well positioned to benefit from the results of your hard-working committee, who will be looking to support members with improved services and opportunities.

The committee conducted a major review of the Club's financial processes and treatments and have implemented changes to the way we capture, monitor and report the Club's financial activities. More details of these changes can be found in the Treasurer's Report. Special thanks must go to both Viv MacCarthy, whose expertise in this area is invaluable to the Club, and Sam Shields whose customary leviathan efforts have restructured our accounts providing a much clearer picture of the Club's financial position. Also, a special mention here to Vice President, Steve Hill, who apart from running every club night so successfully, has been working tirelessly behind the scenes helping to keep the Club on an even keel, although there have been occasions where he has allowed work to interfere with Swimming Club business! Great job thanks Steve.

I also want to acknowledge and thank each member of the committee without whom the club cannot function. Again, these people work hard behind the scenes and are perhaps seldom seen, but keep the Club running efficiently throughout the year selflessly giving up their time "for the swimmers" and making for a very healthy club!

The committee is already investigating the acquisition of equipment to better service our members, as well as provide them with the necessary financial support to participate at local, state, national and international events.

It's been a pleasure to spend the last 12 months serving as your President. There were several changes to the face of the committee at the start of the year and they have delivered a positive drive and commitment with the future of our swimmers as their priority.

There were some departures from the committee due to personal circumstances through the year and it is appropriate to thank Martyn Clancy-Lowe, Geraldine Peel, Liz Atkin and Francis Williams for their contribution to the Club. It is also likely there will be a number of new faces joining the committee at our Annual General Meeting and I look forward to seeing them carry on the good work from the past year.

Activities:

A major part of the West Coast Swimming Club is the importance of our Stingray Squad and its continued growth. It's a pleasure to be involved with the Stingrays and to know that the rewards are so obviously etched on the faces of the participants every Saturday morning. Stingray Squad members have been active and enthusiastic participants at most of our Club Nights and we look forward to an even greater involvement from them in our Club "community".

A number of Member Forums were held during the year with some wide-ranging topics providing members and their families with an entertaining and informative opportunity to make the most of their time in swimming. There were some very positive 'testimonials' received from people who attended the forums, which are convincing enough to make sure that more forums will be planned in the new season.

Coaching:

Recent competition results demonstrate that Mel Tantrum Coaching is on the right track to get the very best out of our competitive swimming group. The re-structure of Mel Tantrum's coaching services will prove to be very timely, particularly when considering the significant shift towards younger competitive swimmers at the Club.

Mel Tantrum's continued commitment to delivering the Club a quality coaching service should be commended. She enjoys the 100% support of a united and loyal committee, with the sole objective for all of us being the improved performance and success of our Club and its members.

Marketing & Promotion:

The Club's financial stability has been, in part, due to the success of our major fund-raising meets in 'The D'Orsogna Cup' and the 'Bell Meet'. Congratulations to all of the committee members and their support group who made both of these events a success in the 2009-10 season. We are already planning for this year's 'D'Orsogna Cup', which this year will be swum on the 28th of November. We are in the process of preparing sponsorship packages and look forward to getting plenty of support from our membership group.

The Club's monthly 'Stinger' newsletter and weekly updates has made sure that just about everyone knows what is going on around the Club. Big thanks must go out to our Membership Registrar Rebecca Glover, who compiles the monthly and weekly news reports. Rebecca was also responsible for setting up the new-look website and making sure that all news and competition results are available to members on-line.

A major priority of the new committee this season will be to secure sponsorship and fundraising opportunities for the Club. The support and commitment of the West Coast Swimming Club family will be very important in ensuring that the Club continues to go from strength-to strength. If a happy club is a healthy club by any standard of measurement, then West Coast has a very bright future.

Head Coach Report

Season 2009/10 was another spectacular year for West Coast Swimming Club at the highest level of swimming. Building on the success of season 2008/09 when the club produced Beijing Olympic Silver Medallist Eamon Sullivan and Paralympic Gold Medallist Katrina Porter, the club continued to develop and support champions such as AIS-based Tommaso D'Orsogna.

In 2008, while based in Perth, Tommaso D'Orsogna made his first Australian Youth Teams for the World Youth Championships in Monterrey, Mexico and the Junior Pan Pacific Championships in Guam. In July 2009, D'Orsogna won bronze as part of the 4x200m Freestyle Relay Team at the FINA World Championships in Rome, Italy setting a new Commonwealth and Australian Record. At the same meet, Tommaso placed 18th in the 200m IM and set a new Australian Age record. At the AIS International Meet in Canberra in November 2009, Tommaso won both the 100m and 200m Freestyle events and set new 100m Freestyle Australian Age and All Comers Records. Since moving to the AIS, Tommaso has gained selection for the 2010 Pan Pacific Championships in the USA in August, 2010 Delhi Commonwealth Games in India in October, and the 2010 FINA World Short Course Championships in Dubai, UAE in December. To top it off, Tommaso was awarded the 2009 Swimming WA Swimmer of the Year Award. Tommaso continues to acknowledge West Coast Swimming Club in his development as a World Class Swimmer.

At the **2009 Australian Short Course Championships** in Hobart, Tasmania, West Coast was represented by Tommaso D'Orsogna, Katrina Porter, Gianna Leone, and Jessica Mitchell. Tommaso won his first Australian Open title in the 200m Freestyle and broke Grant Hackett's Australian All Comers Record. Tommaso also swam eight PBs in 8 events and qualified for finals in every event he entered. Katrina broke the Australian SC Record for the 100m Backstroke in the heats, broke the World Record and won gold in the finals, and gained selection for the 1st IPC World Short Course Championships in Brazil in December 2009. In Brazil, Katrina won silver in the 100m Breaststroke, bronze in 100m Backstroke and bronze in the 4x100m Freestyle Relay (34 point).

Swimming WA selected a team of 20 of the best Age Group swimmers to represent Western Australia at the inaugural **2009 State Teams Age Championships** at the AIS in Canberra. The team included three West Coast swimmers. Mark Ferguson placed 2nd in both the 50m Backstroke and 50m Butterfly skins events, 2nd in the 100m Backstroke and 5th in the 200m Backstroke. Alex Schubach placed 5th in the 200m Freestyle and 6th in the 100m Freestyle, while Jamie Sturgeon placed 2nd in the 50m Backstroke skins and 3rd in the 100m Backstroke. Swimming WA also selected an Age Group Development Team to travel to Kuala Lumpur in January as part of the **Indian Ocean All Stars Tour**. Alisha Hodgetts and I both travelled to Malaysia for this development opportunity.

In February 2010, the West Coast Team of Andrew Warnock, Tom Atkin, and Giorja Ralston travelled to Lake Nagambie in Victoria for the **2010 Australian Open Water Championships**. All swimmers competed in their age group 5km event and finished 12th, 15th and 23rd respectively.

West Coast was represented by Tommaso D'Orsogna at the **2010 Australian Open Championships** in Sydney, New South Wales in March. Tommaso won silver in the 100m Freestyle, bronze in the 200m IM, and placed 5th in the 200m Freestyle. These results ensured his selection on the 2010 Pan Pacs Team to the USA.

A team of 14 swimmers, including 12 debutants, travelled to the **2010 Australian Age Championships** held at the Sydney Olympic Park Aquatic Centre, New South Wales. The team included Mark Ferguson, Ben Tapley, Sam Forward, Ryan Pallas, Jack Gangemi, Andrew Warnock, Kyle Robinson, Thurston Hewitt, Adam Lim, Madi Hopkins, Alisha Hodgetts, Sacha Downing, Shelby Carstens and Shannon Marlborough. The best performer was Mark Ferguson who placed 5th in the final of the 16 year old boys 100m Backstroke and 11th overall in the 50m Freestyle, following a swim-off situation. The boys 16 and under 4x100m Medley Relay Team of Ferguson, Tapley, Forward and Pallas placed 7th in the final. Most improved was Sam Forward with a huge PB and 13th place in the 50m Freestyle.

The support of West Coast Swimming Club, WAIS, Swimming WA, and Challenge Stadium must be acknowledged and recognized for our elite squads. Without all of their support, our highest performing athletes would not have achieved the results they have. Thank you also to our sponsors for their continued support of our club members.

West Coast swimmers continued to perform exceptionally well at State level competitions. Special mention should be made of 16 year old Mark Ferguson who won two titles at the **WA State Open Championships** in January 2010 and five gold medals at the **WA State Age Championships**. Mark convincingly beat a stellar field of significantly older athletes at State Opens and claimed victory in the 50m Backstroke and 50m Butterfly. All individual performances at the State Championships (Long Course and Short Course) are recorded within this Annual Report. Take the time to read and reflect on the outstanding performances of all swimmers from various squads, from junior to opens. Well done to all title holders, medallists, finalists, and those achieving PBs.

The Swimming WA 2010/11 Squads have been expanded this season and 9 West Coast swimmers were identified in the SWA High Performance Pathway. Mark Ferguson earned a place in the prestigious Youth Squad, while Sam Forward, Jack Gangemi, Alisha Hodgetts, Madi Hopkins, Ryan Pallas, Kyle Robinson, Ben Tapley, and Andrew Warnock all gained selection for the Bronze Development Squad. A highlight of the year for the high performance squads was watching the progression of our next tier of swimmers. A total of 14 youth swimmers were awarded Swimming Australia "Youth Performance Squad" status (listed elsewhere in this Annual Report) and 44 junior swimmers achieved Swimming Australia "JX" awards (up from 38 in season 2008/09). Congratulations to the following 17 swimmers (up from 15 swimmers in 2008/09) on achieving Gold or Gold Star status in 2009/10: Macauley Blair, Shelby Carstens, Max Contessi, Amy Farrell, Luke Fowler, Ashleigh Glover, Louise Hewitt, Jared Hill, William Lantzke, Cooper Lindsay, Alex Milligan, Laura Murray, Raife Sillence, Beatrice Tay, Brandon Tay, Geordi Tsigotis, and Maggie White. These are some of the names of our future stars, so watch out for these and others coming through the junior ranks.

In the **Club Premiership** competition, we maintained our place in the A Grade with a 5th placing. Congratulations to the Arena Swim Club for their first A Grade Premiership title. As a club, we should be very proud of our efforts on the night, maintaining more than a decade in the A Grade competition. We will re-build and be back on top soon!

From a club and team-building perspective, the **Blue Pennant** series of meets achieved the aim of bringing together all our squads for the common goal of swimming as a team. It was a great achievement to win all four meets, however, this was not the sole purpose of participating in the Blue Pennants. A total of 85 swimmers competed in the series, a testament to the size and depth of our talent pool. Well done to all swimmers and parents for getting involved and supporting this series.

Season 2009/10 also saw significant improvements the coaching program. An enormous amount of time and effort was put into improving the squad structure, ensuring a seamless transition from the junior to elite squads. This season we welcomed coaches Chris (CJ) Jongsma (National Age Squad), Kim MacCarthy (National Age Development Squad), Glenn Gerber (Intermediate Advanced Squad), Steve Schmidt (Intermediate Squad) and several Junior squad coaches including Daniel Rodgers, Matt Smith, Sophie Patterson, Lauren Winter, Nate Ruback, and Lil Duckett. I cannot thank these coaches enough for their hard work and commitment to ensure that the coaching program achieves the highest standards and provides the best environment for our swimmers to flourish. Thank you again to all coaches in the program. It is only with your hard work, commitment and dedication that we have achieved these outstanding results this season.

The West Coast Committee continues to work tirelessly in conjunction with the coaching program to provide quality services to our members. Thank you to President Chris Jongsma, Vice President Steve Hill, Secretary Sam Shields, Treasurer Viv MacCarthy for the huge effort and countless hours that are put in "behind the scenes" to make this club the success that it is. Rebecca Glover has done a fantastic job as Club Registrar along with her multiple roles as newsletter publisher and website coordinator. Paulette Contessi has exceeded her role as junior liaison and contributes to several operational areas of the committee above and beyond her call of duty. Jane Robinson has done another amazing year with uniforms this season, Liz Atkin raised plenty of funds and Christine Murray kept the timekeeping rosters organized. Finally, Elise Gray has done a stellar job in coordinating the Stingrays Squad on Saturday mornings and encouraging our Stingrays members along to club nights. To **all** the committee members, thank you for getting involved in your children's sport. It is a team effort to make this club "tick" so well.

Finally, may the success of this and previous years lay the foundation and show the way for the current crop of swimmers in this amazing club to develop and shine on the world and national stage. We have a fantastic environment, world class facilities, passionate and dedicated coaches, a hard-working committee, a strong group of volunteers and a great network of parents on hand. Keep up the great work and keep a positive attitude. I look forward to reporting on our achievements in 2010/11.

Club Championships

There was a great swimmer turnout for the West Coast Swimming Club's 2010 Club Championships with 64 members racing in the pool at Challenge Stadium on Saturday 27 March 2010.

Some fantastic performances were highlighted by:

- Three new West Coast Swimming Club 'LC Age' records;
- 49 of the 64 swimmers achieving at least one 'Club Night' PB; &
- 113 individual 'Club Night' PB's.

The stand-out PB performances in the 50-metre Club Championship events came from 11-year-old Emma Kriening and 13-year-old Alisha Hodgetts.

Emma recorded a 6.2 second PB stopping the clock in her 50m Butterfly heat at 42.70 seconds. Her previous 'Club Night' PB time was only recorded in December.

Alisha also swam an impressive 'Club Night' PB slicing 5.70 seconds off her previous 50m Butterfly time that was set at October's 'Junior Virtual Speedster Meet'.

There were also some outstanding 'Club Night' PB performances in the 200m Individual Medley event. 11-year-old Hadley Lindsay scored the biggest PB with a 14.03 second improvement over her previous mark, which she set at the 'Junior Virtual Speedster Meet' in October 2009. 13 year old Kyle Robinson improved his 200 IM time by 11.59 seconds to a 2:35.39 and 8 year old Joel Hill dropped 11.30 seconds off his previous 200 IM time that he set at the March Club Night only a few weeks prior.

Thanks to all of the committee members and parents who volunteered as officials and timekeepers, making it possible for the Club to host 9 consecutive "official timed" meets.

Stingrays Squad

The last 12 months has seen new members and a greater competitive spirit amongst its swimmers. The addition of West Coast Swim club members volunteering their time and skill to support the Stingrays on Saturday morning sessions has been very well received by the kids, coaches and Stingray parents, adding to the great spirit on pool deck and in the pool.

Participation at Club night has increased, with 8 Stingrays swimming in these nights over the course of the season in a variety of events. Both technique and times have improved for the Stingray kids, focusing on reaching their PB. Three of the Stingray swimmers have added week day squad sessions in Mel Tantrum Coaching squads to their schedules with competitive swimming on the horizon.

By the end of the financial year, there were 13 Stingray club members and we have continued to garner great interest from the disabled community with many enquiries.

A huge thank you goes to Chris Jongsma, Lisa Bates and Diane Shepherd for volunteering their services to coach the kids. Their reliability, enthusiasm and dedication are greatly appreciated. Thanks also to the many West Coast swimmers who help with the coaching and to Mel Tantrum for her continued support of the Stingrays.

The Stingray group is a specialist mini squad within the club and has West Coast Swim Club committee representation. Funding continues to be on the agenda and a Stingrays charter has been approved by the Committee. A strategy for corporate support was being formulated as the financial year drew to a close as well as an introduction of a small participation fee.

Education & Training

West Coast Swimming Club expanded its support of developing its people including swimmers, parents, coaches and volunteers in 2009/10 by conducting education seminars and providing subsidies to enable attendance at courses and workshops.

Swimmer & Parent Education Seminars

Four swimmer and parent workshops were conducted over the 2009/10 season with sponsorship support from Healthway assisting with subsidised costs for club members.

- The first session was conducted October 2009 with 65 swimmers, parents and coaches attending the “Season Launch Meeting” with an interactive session on the club’s season goals and the swimming team goals for 2009/10.
- 80 swimmers, parents and coaches attended a “Nutrition Seminar” in November 2009 presented by dynamic nutrition educator, Helen Frost.
- An “Injury Prevention Workshop” was attended by 35 swimmers, parents and coaches in January 2010 presented by Sports Medicine WA.
- The fourth and final seminar titled “The Athlete Pathway” was conducted in February 2010 with presentations from Western Australian Institute of Sport’s Swimming High Performance Manager, Greg Hodge and Anna Inglis from Swimming WA’s Competition and Planning Committee with attendance by 30 swimmers, parents and coaches.

Coach Education and Professional Development

With the sponsorship received from Healthway, the club provided a subsidy to member, Daniel Rodgers to complete the Green License Coaching Accreditation Course. Head Coach, Mel Tantrum was provided funding support towards attending Leadership Coaching Sessions with Perth company, People Solutions, through funding received from the Australian Sports Commission’s Women In Leadership Grant.

Volunteer Education & Training

The Women In Leadership Grant also assisted club members, Geraldine Peel to attend a MYOB Bookkeeping Course, Paulette Contessi, a Sponsorship Course and Elise Gray, a Fundraising Course.

Targeted Meets Calendar & Coach Attendance at Meets

Coaches from Mel Tantrum met at the beginning of the winter and summer season and planned the targeted meets calendar. The most appropriate swim meets were selected for members based on several factors including the importance of meet (ie National or State level meet), program of events offered, timing (ie proximity to Nationals or States), and quality of competition. Meets were selected for both juniors and seniors. Once the targeted meets calendar was developed by the coaches, it was endorsed by the West Coast Committee and then published to all members. Members were then encouraged to submit entries to targeted meets and a coach or coaches were present to supervise warm ups, give pre- and post-race instructions, and provide encouragement and feedback to all West Coast swimmers.

Shell Meet

West Coast held a Shell Novice Meet on Saturday 6 December 2009 in the outdoor 10 lane pool. A total of 112 competitors aged 7 and over signed up and swam over 300 races. 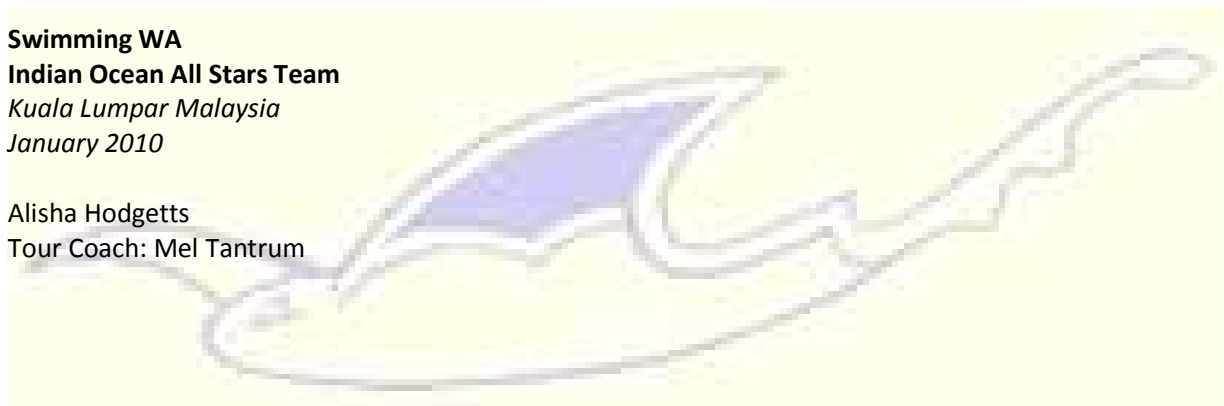

Treasurer's Report

For the year ended 30th June 2010

Summary of Result

The Club's financial performance in fiscal year 2010 shows net income from operations of \$22,842. Net assets of \$56,406 include a cash balance of \$54,154. The Club's financial position is stronger than prior year, with Member's Equity increasing by 69% from \$33,565 to \$56,411.

Statement of Activities (Profit & Loss)

Net income from activities has been derived from Membership, \$20,366, Fundraising, \$2,887, Uniform Sales, \$1,774, the net impact from Grants and associated activities, \$2,161, and from surplus funds set aside for Stingray activities, \$4,037. This income has been offset by losses from the Club's total swimming program, (\$1,681) and the cost of Administration activities, (\$6,702). Sponsorship of \$7,396 has been captured within the activity it has supported. For example, Stingray sponsorship of \$3,756, and D'Orsogna Sponsorship of \$3,640, appears within their activity summaries. Similarly, Stingray donations of \$1,580 have been captured within the Stingrays activity summary.

Attached is a **Profit & Loss Statement**, showing Income and Expenses grouped into income or cost types. Also attached is a **Detailed Statement of Activities**. Both reports provide greater detail of the Club's operating performance for the year.

Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet)

The club's financial 'health' is represented by the '**Statement of Financial Position**' or '**Balance Sheet**' which has been attached. This statement provides a picture of the Club's 'net worth' and compares this with the prior year so that we can see what changes have occurred. The summary, below, explains the values which appear on the Statement.

Assets

Cash at bank comprises \$54,154 which is spread between operating and investment accounts. The Club's Debtors balance of \$1,962 represents amounts to be collected from Members and other Debtors. This is the first year where the club has provided records for charges and payments received. The balance includes a total value of \$1,780 or 91% that relates to June 2010 invoices, and represents swimmer contributions for the recent Albany trip. These invoices were settled early in July. The remaining 9% is made up of small under or over payments for meet entries with most Members responding quickly to initial requests in July 2010. There is one problematic debt of \$43 which may need to be written off in 2011.

A value of \$4,881 is held as Uniform Inventory and represents the cost of uniforms purchased by the Club. Similarly, "Swimming for Parents" books hold a value of \$812. Both stock values will be expensed at the time of sale to Members with any profit recorded as income.

Other Assets include a balance of \$2,419 which represents payments made in the current year for accommodation and other costs for the Albany Trip in July 2010. This value will appear as an expense in the new year as of 1st July 2010. A pre-paid deposit of \$400 remains with a Supplier and is being withheld for a future bowling activity.

Following a physical audit of assets and reconciliation of the Balance Sheet account, Assets have been valued at \$3,300 at the time of their purchase. This figure has been depreciated by \$660, (two years depreciation), to provide a book value of \$2,640 on the balance sheet. In addition, a value of \$1,824 has been written back to expenses in the year. This figure represents minor equipment purchases and following accounting guidelines, is required to be expensed in the year of purchase. The new equipment register is attached for your information.

Liabilities

The Club has closed the year with a nil balance in Creditors (payments owing to suppliers). All Grants have been acquitted with activity set out in the **Detailed Statement of Activities**. Other liabilities include \$10,161 which represents next year's income for Membership and payments for Albany meet entries. This amount will be recorded as income on 1st July 2010. The only other liability, \$700, is a donation which has been preserved for equipment purchases.

Changes in the way we are working

The WCSC Committee has implemented changes to the way we capture, monitor and report the club's financial activities. Improved transparency of financial information allows the committee and Members to more accurately review the Club's operations and to successfully plan for future activities. This approach has required a reconstruction of the club's financial records for the first half of the year and continuing development of processes throughout the remainder of the year. Your patience and understanding throughout this change period has been greatly appreciated.

Some of the changes include:

1. Member transactions

Members have been allocated 'accounts' and can now view their charges and payments on request. This approach provides clarity around charges raised and Member payments for meet entries, uniform and other purchases.

2. Tracking costs by Activity

Members and the Committee now have visibility of the Club's operating performance for each activity undertaken. Our new processes allow reporting of income and expenses by meet, by fundraising event, by administration activity, by Grant, or other event.

3. Asset and Equipment management and control:

The Club's fixed asset register has been reconstructed in line with accepted accounting principles. The reconstruction has involved a physical asset audit and an audit of the Balance Sheet. All assets and minor equipment have been captured in an Equipment Register. Each item has been assigned an owner who will have responsibility for managing the asset or equipment.

4. Uniform and other Inventory:

The Club now records Uniforms and any other sale items as inventory. Club uniform purchases are now recorded as an Asset until the point at which they are sold. At the time of sale, the cost of the uniform or other inventory item is recorded as an expense.
